

# Squirrel Trail

## Operating Procedures



- A First Aid kit must be available at all times and its location should be made known to all participants.
- Horseplay of any kind should be discouraged at all times.
- Leaders must be aware of their responsibility for the whole group at all times and not allow themselves to be distracted.
- Leaders should supervise their group with ratios in line with current Scout guidelines,
- Young people to be briefed to stay as a group and not run off ahead.
- Leader in charge to assist with the reading of the first clue which is on the wall at the tuck shop
- Follow the clues until you reach the last one which directs you back to the shop to purchase the trail badges if you wish

Number	Location	Points to	Wording on Sign
1	Tuck Shop	Campfire Hollow	Crackling flames and stories told, A place for songs when nights are cold. Follow the path where memories glow. To the fire circle you must go!
2	Campfire Hollow	Archery Range	Take your aim and stand up tall, Pull it back and let it fall! Where arrows fly and targets wait— Find the spot to test your aim straight!
3	Archery Range	Shower Block	After all the fun and play, There's a place to rinse away. Water runs both night and day— Find where dirt is washed away!
4	Shower Block	Lowe's Lane Water Tap	Round a bend and up the hill, this water source won't make you ill, a tap on the head may make you think, this is the place to get a drink.
5	Lowe's Lane Water Tap	Bowring Hut	People arrive and people go, Through one main place we all must know. The way in where adventures start—Find the entrance to camp's heart!
6	Bowring Hut	Cave Bus	Not a cave and not a ride, But something fun you can explore inside! looks like wheels once took it far— Now it's parked where we all are!
7	Cave Bus	Delph Bothy	A place to sleep after adventures told, this wooden building, many memories hold, sleepy heads now must rest, tomorrow we will "do our best"
8	Delph Bothy	BP's Tree	From tiny acorns large trees grow, this one was planted long, long ago. Our founder chose this special place, we've put a plaque to mark it's base
9	BP's Tree	Phone Box	In days of old before the mobile, this big red box was oh, so noble, Find the place where people talked, it's near to here, not far to walk.
10	Phone Box	Finish	Well done, you have successfully completed the trail and found all my friends. If your leader says so, you can now go to to the tuck shop or the office to buy a special Squirrel Trail Badge
